

Spray Can Paints

Silicon Spray Cans:

Specifically formulated spray can paint containing a silicon ingredient mixed with solvent & pigment (usually Black).

Silver Extractor Spray Cans:

Silver spray can paint with an extreme resistance to heat & solvent. It is normally used to coat extractors on motor vehicles.

Montana Spray Cans:

These spray can paints are very high in pigment colour levels and, like traditional spray can paints, contain 5 ball bearings to separate paint to produce sharp lines with maximum pigment concentration. Imported from the U.S & Mexico, cost is usually AUD\$35 each. The label on the can proudly boasts that it is "irremovable".

Inks

Line Marking Ink:

Usually Yellow, Orange or White, it contains high concentrations of pigment and the hard wearing capabilities is what they are designed for. Can cause permanent damage on Sandstone, Limestone & Bitumen.

Motor Markers:

Used by the Motor Industry to mark unpainted panels on vehicles. Usually White or Orange and designed to impregnate heavily onto metal surfaces.

Felt Pen Markers All of these markers are formulated by vandals and the ingredients in them are as follows:

Raven Oil:

A leather stain used for colouring shoes, belts, handbags etc.

Feast & Watson Wood Stain:

Industrial Wood Stain that is added to Poska Pens. This stain is usually applied when staining wood at 1 part Stain /20 parts Thinners. When added at full strength, these Pens are the most potent defacing medium.

Balfours Ink:

High heat resistant ink used on food wrappers for the fast food industry so that the food can be heated in the microwaves. Very challenging to remove.

Silicon Markers:

Silicon beads are heated, added to ink and brake fluid, liquefied, then poured into a texta. Glycerine is also added so that the ink will run...a potent and nasty medium. When applied, it will leave a streaky appearance and, when dry forms a crust. The effort required to remove this is considerable and, if applied to Sandstone, can very costly to remove.

Fire Extinguishers:

Spray Can Paint is added to a fire extinguisher and, under pressure, it allows the vandals to reach extreme heights to vandalise. Recently, one graffiti vandal "SINCH:", added fine rubber granules to the paint, this formed a crust when dry. Removal was considerably difficult as rubber can withstand extreme heat.

GRAFFITI REMOVER KIT 1

This Kit Bucket will remove texta, spraycan, biro etc from non-masonry surfaces including Colourbond, Galvanised, Powder Coat, Glass & Plastic.

The contents of Kit #1 will remove up to 8 sqm.

**BRICK & STONE
GRAFFITI

Only intended for graffiti on bare (unpainted) brick, stone, concrete, masonry etc.

1. Pour a small amount into one of the buckets supplied and brush it onto the graffiti "flood coating" as you go.
2. Re-apply 3 times, leaving approx 3 minutes between each application and a final 3 minutes after applying the last "flooding".
3. Agitate the surface with a nylon brush and then rinse off.

**TEXTA & FELTPEN

Used for removing graffiti from painted walls, signs, desks, doors, playground equipment, whiteboards etc.

1. Pour a small quantity into another bucket.
2. Brush it onto the graffiti in very small areas at a time, agitating with the brush.
3. Using a damp cloth, wipe the dissolved graffiti as you proceed.

**TEXTA & FELTPEN
SHADOW
REMOVER**

Only used for felt pen, texta & permanent markers that may have left 'burnt in' shadows. After the application of the other products on any surface like brick, paintwork:

1. Pour small quantity into a bucket and apply with a brush directly onto the shadow or stain.
2. Allow to sit until the shadow/stain has disappeared. This product can be left on for extended periods (overnight).
3. Using a damp cloth, wipe off any residue left once the shadow has disappeared.

**GRAFFITI
EASYWIPES**

Intended for use on small areas of graffiti (eg: desks, doors, painted walls etc)

1. Use one Graffiti Easywipe and wipe off graffiti
2. With a damp cloth, wipe off any residue
3. With a clean dry cloth, dry the surface
